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MINUTES CITY COMMISSION BUDGET FINAL PUBLIC HEARING SEPTEMBER 21, 2016 – 6:00 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER

Chair Copeland called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

PLEDGE TO THE FLAG

ROLL CALL

1. OPEN 2016/2017 BUDGET HEARING

Chair Copeland opened the Budget Public Hearing.

2. DISCUSS PROPOSED FINAL BUDGET'S PERCENTAGE INCREASE IN MILLAGE OVER ROLLED-BACK RATE TO FUND BUDGET (IF ANY), AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES FOR WHICH AD VALOREM TAXES ARE BEING INCREASED/DECREASED.

Mayor Murphy informed there had been no changes made to the Budget.

Chair Copeland announced the final millage rate proposed is 2.05. The percent increase over the rolled-back rate is 9.84%, with the rolled-back rate being 1.8664. The rolled-back rate is the tax rate that would bring in the same amount of dollars from the previous year. Ad Valorem taxes are being increased to provide services to meet the expenses of this proposed tentative budget.

4. CLOSE PUBLIC COMMENT

Chair Copeland closed the Public Hearing.

5. AMEND FINAL BUDGET, IF NECESSARY

Chair Copeland asked if there was any amendment to the Final Budget. There was none.

6. RECOMPUTE FINAL MILLAGE – ANNOUNCE PERCENT MILLAGE EXCEEDS (IF ANY) THE ROLLED-BACK RATE, IF MILLAGE EXCEEDS THE ROLLED-ACK RATE, THIS IS CHARACTERIZED AS THE PERCENTAGE INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAXES.

7. CONSIDER ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION R-16-718 – ADOPTING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE TAX YEAR 2016.

The Resolution title was read into the record.

Motion: Move that Resolution R-16-718 be approved for adoption.

Action: Approved. Moved by Commissioner Woodland, Seconded by Commissioner Webb.

Motion carried – All Aye.

8. CONSIDER ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION R-16-719 – ADOPTING THE 2016/2017 BUDGET

The Resolution title was read into the record.

Motion: Move that Resolution R-16-719 be approved for adoption.

Action: Approved. Moved by Commissioner Webb, Seconded by Vice-Chair Yetter.

Motion carried – All Aye.

9. SECOND READING – ORDINANCE 16-821 – ADOPTING THE BUDGET FY 2016/2017, AND RECEIPT AND COLLECTION OF AD VALOREM TAXES

The Ordinance title was read into the record.

Motion: Move that Ordinance 16-821 be approved for Second Reading and Adoption.

Action: Approved. Moved by Vice-Chair Yetter, Seconded by Commissioner Carter.

Motion carried – All Aye.
