### EMERGENCY MEETING

#### 1. City Pier FEMA Response

*Mayor Murphy* stated that for the last nine or ten months we have, well LeAnne has been working with FEMA. We have provided a lot of information to FEMA including estimate. LeAnne has done a sterling job working on this to date. We have a recommendation from FEMA so we can agree with this or challenge this. If we challenge this, we would have to send everything all over again. If we concur with this, then we move forward with this. It will then go to the State of Florida. The bottom line is that if you vote today to accept this, we could begin driving piles in late October or early November. We submitted 1.8 Million and we would get 75% which comes out to 1.3 Million. If we challenge this, we may be able to get another \$100,000 to \$150,000. The challenge would be the scouring of the pilings and to determine what was caused by Hurricane Irma and what was prior to the storm. He recommends that we don't challenge the scouring.

*Mayor Murphy* discussed the revenues that will be used for our City Pier.
