1. **BUILDING OFFICIAL SELECTION PROCESS**

Commissioner Linda Cramer asked for clarity under the job description, to indicate that the position would be responsible for Code Enforcement. Commissioner Chuck Webb noted that the job description was not being discussed at this meeting, but rather the selection process.

Chair John Quam asked if all the Commissioners agreed with the revised interviewing process. Commissioner Cramer said she did not have a problem with the new process, but felt the more important issue was what the job description would be.
