

Manatee County Household Hazardous Waste/E-Scrap Collection is FREE for Residential Citizens.

For your convenience, Manatee County in conjunction with the Cities of Anna Maria, Holmes Beach, Bradenton Beach, and Longboat Key are having a Household Hazardous Waste/E-Scrap Collection for the island residents to dispose of solvents, latex and oil base paints, garden pesticides, household chemicals, ammunition, flares, waste oil, propane tanks, fluorescent lamps, any mercury containing devices (thermostats, thermometers, float switches from boat bilges), pool chemicals, old gasoline (in gasoline containers), household, auto, and marine batteries. We are also collecting televisions, computer components (printers, scanners, fax machines, CPU's keyboards), copiers, video and audio equipment, small household electrical appliances (microwaves, hair dryers, irons, cell phones, digital cameras, battery chargers).

We **DO NOT** accept **Radioactive** (smoke detectors) and **Bio-Hazardous** Materials (sharps being needles).

Small businesses which generate a small quantity of Hazardous Waste or E-Scrap may bring waste to the above location they will have to pay contractor on site for disposal.
